Each homeroom teacher will fill out a schedule for the day; it will be sent home with each student and can be found on the teacher web pages.

Refreshments will be provided in each foyer. Please finish & dispose of your goodies and beverages before leaving the foyer to visit your child’s classroom.

To help ensure that the children’s learning experiences on this special day is beneficial for them as the classroom visitations are for you, the Wayne staff requests the following of our parent visitors -

1. Please adhere to the scheduled hours of visitation.
2. Please make other arrangements for younger children during your Visit. We have found that preschoolers tend to be very interested In the classroom happenings and are not able to be quiet observers.
3. Please enter the classroom quietly and sit in the designated area.
4. Please refrain from engaging in conversation with other parent Visitors during your classroom visit, as this noise carries to the Front of the room and becomes a major distraction to the students.
5. Please enter into activities at the teacher’s invitation only, as the The teacher is responsible for all learning activities and classroom management.
6. Please remember this is not a parent-teacher conference time.
7. With so many parents anxious to visit the school during American Education Week, we ask that you only visit the classrooms in which your child is currently participating.

9. Please do not park in the bus loop.
