Dear Parents and Guardians,

With the end of the school year approaching, we are very excited for our seniors as they look to celebrate their Prom on Saturday, June 1st at The Franklin Institute, and our Post-Prom at Radnor High School. Throughout the course of the year, much work has been done by the 12th grade class sponsors, the senior class officers, and our Post-Prom committee to prepare for these events. As we look forward to Prom and Post-Prom, here is some information regarding what you can expect:

Prom

Doors will open at 7:00 PM. Students must arrive at The Franklin Institute by 7:45 PM and are not permitted to leave before 10:30 PM. We have a list of every student who purchased a ticket, their cell phone #, and the name of their date. As the students arrive they will need to check in with the teacher chaperones who will make sure their name and ticket number correspond. We will have administrators, 10-15 teacher chaperones, and security guards from both the school and The Franklin Institute in attendance. The 12th grade class sponsors will call home for all students scheduled to attend that do not arrive to The Franklin Institute by 7:45 PM. Finally, students are encouraged to bring flip-flops or flats if they anticipate the shoes they will be wearing may be uncomfortable. The Franklin Institute does not permit dancing barefoot or in socks.

Post-Prom

The Post-Prom party is held at Radnor High School from 11:30 PM to 4:00 AM. This year students must sign up for the Post-Prom by filling out [a Google form](#). A link is available in the updates section of the Class of 2019 Schoology page. The form details rules and expectations and will be used as the attendance list at check in. If your student registers to attend the Post-Prom, but must cancel after registering, please call 610-293-0855 x3506 by 11:25 PM on Saturday (6/1) and leave a message for Mr. Thomas. Like Prom, students will need to check in with the parent chaperones when they arrive. Administration will call home for all students scheduled to attend that do not arrive by 12:00 AM, whose parents/guardians have not left a message for Mr. Thomas. Students who attend Post-Prom must stay until 3:30 AM. Any student who requests to leave before that time will need parent permission and approval from RHS administration. Parent chaperones, school administrators, and security guards will be present the entire time. No outside food or beverages will be permitted. Students may bring bags/backpacks to Post-Prom, but these personal items will be checked in at the registration table for pickup at the end of the party. Students may keep their phones with them throughout the night. Lastly, parents who are not volunteering at Post-Prom, but who would like to preview the Post-Prom are invited to do so on Saturday (6/1) between 10:00 and 11:00 PM before the seniors arrive.

This will undoubtedly be a great evening.
