



## 2020 – 2021 Summary of Projects Funded

**On behalf of the 2020-2021 PTO Executive Board, we would like to thank all parents, teachers and staff for their generous contributions and invaluable services.** Despite a very challenging year with many unknowns and changing landscape, with your support, grants and programs were fulfilled to serve social, educational and cultural needs. As we look forward to summer break, let's take a moment to reflect on the impact that our PTO has had on the Radnor High School community this year. Here are some of the highlights.

### **Fundraising**

It is with much gratitude and appreciation to RHS families for their donations of time and contributions to the Family Sponsorship Fund (\$2,200), that the PTO is able to support a diverse selection of projects. These contributions allow the PTO to fund so many worthy events, grants, clubs, scholarships and more.

### **Giving Back to Teachers:** Total Teacher Grants = \$3,617

- Nurse's Office – Emergency Clothing for Students - \$200
- Technology Grant covering the RHS Tech fee for three students whose families experienced a change - \$417
- Book Grant, The Distance Learning Playbook, 110 individual copies provided to RHS faculty = \$3100

### **Giving Back to Parents** Total Donations = \$500.00

Each of the four meetings were held virtually over Zoom this year, but the content and conversations no less meaningful and enriching = \$500.00

**Giving Back to the Community:** Total Donation = \$400

To recognize and thank RHS teachers and staff, the PTO provided a pre-packaged Faculty & Staff dinner on the first day of Parent Teacher conferences in November (\$1200). This spring, the PTO recognized Teacher Appreciation Week by providing a pre-packaged breakfast to 140 faculty and staff. (\$400)

The PTO facilitates SAT and ACT Prep Bootcamps at RHS several times a year, conducted virtually over Zoom this year. These are convenient, and affordable review classes open to all students. A percentage of the proceeds are given to the PTO for student initiatives.
