Dear Neighbor,

Over the years we get reports of the successes of our recipients and how our scholarships helped them achieve their educational goals.

Highlighted in this brochure is the testimonial from Mike McBride, Radnor Class of 1982, who attended the University of Delaware and now is the popular advanced math teacher and basketball coach at Radnor High School. He talked about how our \$500, along with other scholarships and working in college, enabled him to meet the financial burden. He also passed along the gratitude of his siblings who also received our scholarships – Matt '83, Lehigh, and now a computer systems designer; Sean '85, Brown, vice-president of Ingersoll-Rand; and Regina, '91, Millersville, third grade teacher in Methacton. This is what we are all about and why we ask you to help us help more.

Last June we awarded 35 scholarships to deserving recipients from the Class of 2008 ranging from \$800 to \$2,000 per year for four years. Following our usual process, we received applications in April, sent them to a local university financial aid officer for need analysis, received a report maintaining privacy with only a need rating for each applicant, held interviews with those meeting our need criteria to explore their commitment to higher education, community involvement, and grades, and presented the award certificates at a reception in June. To continue to receive checks twice a year, the recipients must maintain at least a "C" average and confirm that need continues.

The recipients listed herein include those receiving special or named scholarships reflecting donations in honor of, or in memory of, an individual or from corporate contributions. Those designated "Radnor Scholarship" are covered by our general funds.

Speaking of our funds, we have had good response from the community, corporations and alumni and with our fund-raisers Girls Night Out in April and Breakfast with Santa. However, our major fund-raiser, Fourth of July fireworks, was severely affected by weather in 2007 and again this year. Rather than allow those losses to cut our scholarship program, we went into reserves and increased the budget for the Class of 2008 to \$38,000 recognizing the great need. We are proud to provide this assistance to the Class of 2008 and to continue our commitment to the Classes of 2005, 2006 and 2007 with an annual scholarship budget of over \$125,000.

With the ever-increasing number of students in Radnor who really need financial help to achieve their dreams, our all-volunteer board joins me in asking you to help us provide them some assistance and to make a difference, like it did with the McBride family.
