223. USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES	
1. Purpose	The Board regards the use of bicycles and motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.
2. Authority	The Board shall permit the use of bicycles by students in accordance with district rules, provided that students have been granted permission by the building principal and have obtained parental permission to ride a bicycle to school.
SC 1519	The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district rules, provided that such students are licensed drivers and have followed established procedures and obtained the required permit.
	The Board prohibits the use of skateboards and roller blades on school property.
	The Board shall not be responsible for bicycles or motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The building principal or designee shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking of bicycles and motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to affected students.
	The building principal or designee shall establish standards for granting permits, which contain the warning that infraction of rules may result in revocation of the permit.
4. Guidelines	When parking space is a limiting factor, seniors may be given first priority. Any remaining space will be allocated at the discretion of the administration.
	Administrative procedures will be available in the student handbook.

<p>Pol. 218.1, 226, 227</p> <p>School Code 510, 1519</p>	<p><u>Illegal/Unacceptable Activities</u></p> <p>Reckless driving is prohibited and shall be defined for the purposes of this policy to include any person who drives a motor vehicle on school property carelessly disregarding the rights or safety of others, or in a manner so as to endanger any person or property.</p> <p>Throwing or dumping any waste material including, but not limited to, paper, garbage, bottles, cans, wire, glass or boxes from any motor vehicle is prohibited.</p> <p>Driving or parking vehicle on unpaved areas is prohibited unless specific permission is granted by the administration.</p> <p>Driving any motor vehicle without the knowledge and consent of the owner or other persons in control or possession thereof is prohibited.</p> <p>Operating any vehicle in a speed contest, including those commonly known as drag races is prohibited.</p> <p>No illegal matter such as drugs, alcohol, weapons, explosives or stolen property may be transported, secreted or kept in any motor vehicle brought on school property. The school district reserves the right to search any vehicle entering or parked on school property reasonably suspected of carrying or containing such matter.</p> <p>Driving motor vehicles on school property after 10:00 p.m. or before 6:00 a.m., except for activities authorized by the administration, is prohibited.</p> <p>Students may not loiter in any lot.</p>
