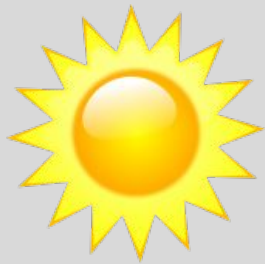
If a student experiences symptoms **PRIOR** to leaving for camp:

Students who experience symptoms **while AT camp**:

- Student will be tested by camp nurse.
- If positive:
 - Student will be isolated
 - Students in learning groups/cabin will “Test-to-Stay”.
 - Cabin will sleep Head-to-Toe

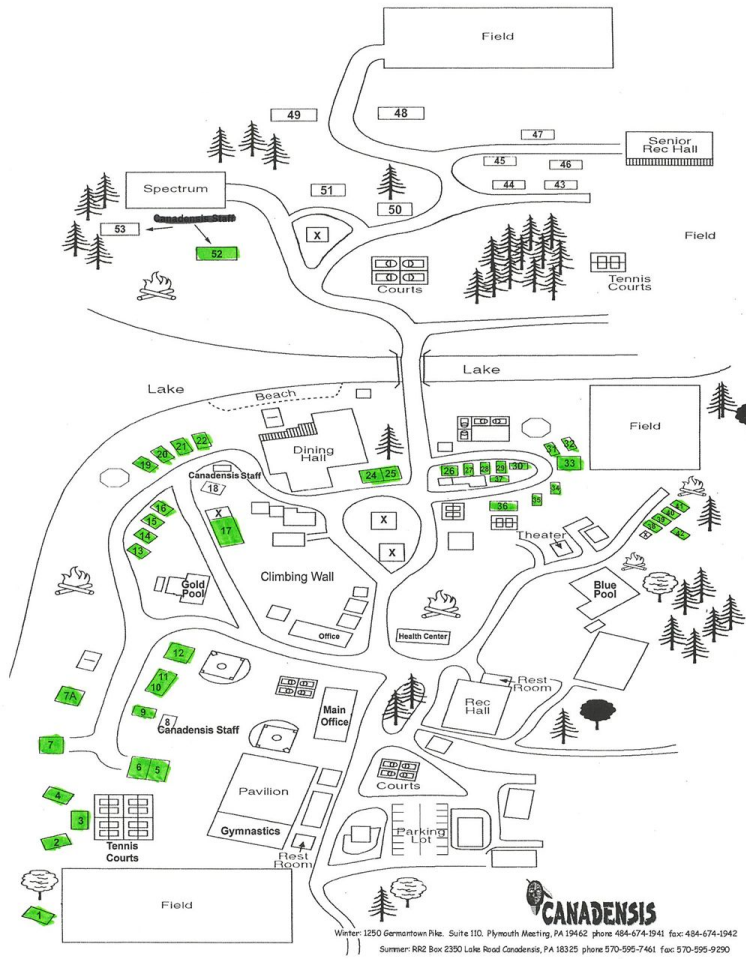
