Step into the "Winsor Room Theater" and view the new release Smallfoot. Light snacks provided. Children under 11 must be accompanied by an adult.

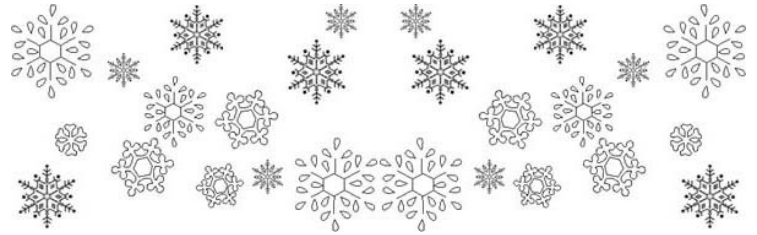
***Book Bites Club**
